

Guidelines for Re-evaluation of Registration and issue of revalidated certificate

1. The registration in CRR will be re-evaluated after every seven years as approved by the General Council in its 21st meeting held on 20-08-02.
2. A revalidated certificate will be issued under the signature of Member Secretary RCI on completion of prescribed conditions of re-evaluation.
3. The Registration of all Rehabilitation Professionals/Personnel except those who have been registered on basis of Bridge course and DPEP Foundation course will be considered for re-evaluation on completion of seven years registration.
 - a) Bridge Course :- The Bridge Course was conducted to provide one time opportunity to those who were working in the field of rehabilitation of persons with disabilities prior to June 1993 without any rehabilitation qualification. The Bridge Course was not an upgradation of qualification and it was only to maintain a status quo, hence re-evaluation of their registration is not required.
 - b) A 45 Days foundation course for Multy-category in service teachers in integrated education is organised under DPEP scheme. The RCI register them only for five years period with condition that they should undergo RCI approved regular/distance mode training programme (Diploma/Degree) during the registration period for continuance of their registration. In this case also re-evaluation not required.
4. Every individual registered in CRR must have attended at least two approved programmes by the Council under CRE/Refresher Programme/Seminar/Workshop in the field of rehabilitation for persons with disabilities to qualify himself/herself for re-evaluation of registration.
5. The RCI will charge re-evaluation of registration fee of Rs. 250/- in a form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of Member Secretary Rehabilitation Council of India, payable at New Delhi.
6. A re-validated certificate will be issued after re-evaluation by the Council. This certificate to be kept with registration certificate by all rehabilitation professional/personnel.
7. Each rehabilitation professional/personnel will provide the following documents with his application for re-evaluation of registration.
 - a) One latest passport size photograph duly attested on back side.
 - b) Attested photocopies of participation certificate of CRE/Refresher Programme/Seminar/Workshop etc. approved by RCI attended during last seven years.
 - c) Attested photocopies of certificates and marksheets of recognised rehabilitation qualifications.
 - d) Re-evaluation application forms in prescribed format, which will be made available on RCI website.
8. Initial CRR will be maintained intact since it will be original one. However, re-evaluation record will be maintained separately in a form of list and also in computer.
9. Any RCI recognised rehabilitation qualification acquired during seven years period of re-evaluation, if no earlier added can be added in registration certificate provided prescribed fee of Rs. 50/- by DD for addition of additional qualification and application on form "C" is sent by the Professional/Personnel alongwith original registration certificate.
