CIRCULAR

In pursuance to Section 18 of the RCI Act, 1992, the Council prescribes the minimum standards of education required for granting recognised rehabilitation qualifications by Universities or institutions in India and also review from time to time.

The Council in its 43rd GC meeting held on 16 February, 2021, has approved the revision of the eligibility criteria for admission to the Bachelor in Audiology & Speech Language Pathology (BASLP) and M.Sc.(Audiology) & M.Sc.(Speech Language Pathology) programmes which are as under:

The revised eligibility criteria for these training programmes will be effective from the academic session 2021-22 onwards.
