
To,

All institutes conducting MASLP programme

It has been notified vide circular no. 2-6/ASLP/2016/RCI dated 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 that combined Master Degree Programme in the area of Speech and Hearing i.e. MASLP shall be discontinued from the academic session 2018-19 onwards and the institutions renewed above programme may choose to offer annually introduced programme either M.Sc. (Speech Language Pathology) or M.Sc. (Audiology) from the next academic session 2018-19. In this circular, it was not clarified that the institution willing to offer M.Sc. (Speech Language Pathology) and M.Sc. (Audiology) may offer both the programmes.

It is to be clarified that as per 76<sup>th</sup> EC meeting of the Council the liberty is open to offer either one course or both the courses subject to fulfillment of other criteria to conduct these courses. This shall be applicable to the institution who are already running MASLP programme. It is further clarified that those who have enrolled/applied for MASLP programme for the session 2018-19 may opt for any of the above two M.Sc. programmes or both. Their online application for MASLP shall be accepted accordingly, provided a separate request letter is submitted to the Council in this matter.

Remaining provisions of the circular dated 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 shall remain unchanged.
