Revised Circular

Sub: Discontinuation of provision of MOU with Special School from the next academic session i.e. 2019-20 academic session and accordingly consideration of such fresh for only two years/batches, initially:-reg.

This is with reference to the decision of the Council taken in 40th GC meeting held on 28/03/2018 that *the liberty of having MoU with special schools for grant of approval of Diploma/Degree level Courses to NGOs has been withdrawn from the next academic session. However Government Institutions/National Institutes/CRCs/Universities may be exempted from the condition of having own special school, however, they should have MoU with special schools but the rider of one special school of one level and one category to be allowed to only to one Course/Institution for teaching practice.*


II. It is also to mention here that the Council has decided and published in the Manual for Assessment of Training Institutions under Special /Inclusive School stating that Training institutions applying for special education/inclusive education related courses should have the facility of Special/Inclusive school (s) as per the following:

“Special School: Should have own special school with strength of minimum 60 children in respective area of disability. MOU with a nearby/local special school may be considered in case the course is run by the Universities/National Institutes/Govt. organizations. The MOU needs to be renewed after every two years. **Also in case of new courses, MOU with a local special school may be considered for the first two years only subject to credentials of the training institution.** Training institution has to submit an affidavit stating that they would have their own special school with required number of students with disabilities within a time period of 2 years and in-case fail to do so that they would have no objection to the Council to close the course”.

III. In view of the above, Council has decided to accord approval on fresh proposals for maximum of two years/batches to those institutions who have MOU with another special school. Approval of two years/batches may be extended based on scores obtained in the joint assessment report provided the institute establishes its own special school (as per the norms **and requirement** of the particular course) within two years and **and has its own college upto Intermediate level and** submit the evidentiary document to the satisfaction of the Council.

IV. Subsequent to above Revised Circular, the Council's earlier Circular No. **8-A/Policy(Recog.)/2009/RCI dated 11th May, 2018 on above subject stands cancelled.**
