Advisory Regarding Fraudulent Communications

It has been brought to the notice of the Council that an unknown individual is falsely representing himself as a senior official of the Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) and attempting to establish communication with stakeholders through unauthorized means. It has been observed that the said individual is using a non-Indian contact number i.e. +6283196490917 to engage with institutions under false pretenses. It is reiterated that all the official communications at RCI are initiated only through Government e-mail domain (@nic.in / @gov.in), details of the emails are available on the RCI website <https://rehabcouncil.nic.in>

In view of the above, all Training Institutes (TTIs) and institutions affiliated with RCI are hereby advised to remain vigilant and refrain from engaging with any suspicious communications through media received from unknown or unverified sources.

Action to be Taken:

- 1. Verification:** All communications claiming to be from RCI must be verified through official channels.
- 2. Reporting:** Any such suspicious communication must be reported immediately to RCI at [msrci-msje@nic.in, rci-depwd@gov.in].
- 3. Awareness:** The contents of this advisory may be disseminated to all concerned staff and stakeholders within your institution.

Necessary legal measures are being initiated by the Council to address this issue, and further updates shall be communicated in due of course.
